Expenses:

- Signs banning personal watercraft (jet skis) were posted at Pondview launch and Sam's Landing
- Largest expense: Newsletter (label costs are up \$.65 from last year)
- o **Donation:** Will donate \$100 to Lake Stewards of Maine to support lake education and plant patrol training

Balance: \$1030.29

- Membership: There are 59 SPWA members

- Association Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2022
 - o Possible Maine Lakes Organization Membership
 - Organization Function: Lake association work; loon restoration project
 - **Membership:** \$2 per member
 - Concern: Is this group controversial; is there overlap with LSM?
 - Pond Water Conditions
 - **Dam Keeper's Report:** There is no updated dam report for 2022; there has been no water going over the dam for a month
 - Water Testing Steve Markarian:
 - Water Clarity Testing: Readings have been more shallow than usual; no rain and low boat traffic; 4.55 meters, normal is 6 meters
 - **Depth:** Maximum depth is 24' today; down a foot; loons are in the deepest part of the pond
 - **PH Testing:** Steve ordered a phosphorus testing kit to test for PH; phosphorus is normally low in the pond (4-5 parts/liter); phosphorus is elevated by run off and fireworks
 - Other Water Tests: We are fine with the tests we use (clarity, PH); pond water quality is good
 - Oxygen monitoring: Steve does not use the equipment; we need to buy and calibrate; equipment is expensive

- Ecoli: It is a waste of time to test for Ecoli randomly; can test near failed waterfront septic systems; telltale sign is algae
- **Testing Results:** Water testing results can be emailed and posted to Saturday Pond Loons Facebook page
- Lake Monitoring for Invasive Aquatic Vegetation Sue LaFleur:
 - Training: Sue, Amy Brown, and Julie Ywoskus attended Invasive Plant Patrol (IPP) training in the spring
 - Plant Patrol: Sue, Amy, and Julie will kayak throughout season to patrol for invasive plants and report to LSM at the end of the season
 - Documentation: Should we buy invasive plant identification brochures to distribute to SPWA members?; trustees will discuss and decide at fall 2022 meeting; may be able to post invasive plant information on the SPWA website
- Ice In / Ice Out Dates: 80% of ice has to be in or out to call the date

Ice In: December 7, 2021Ice Out: April 4, 2022

Pond Wildlife:

- **o** Loons Robin Nureck-Bramswig:
 - Official Loon Count: Robin, Bill Bramswig, Diane Burak, and Julie Ywoskus counted 2 loons on July 16, the official loon count date
 - Loon Nesting: This year there was no loon nest, no eggs, and no chicks
- Other Wildlife: Members have seen a variety of animals including, bobcats, butterflies, deer, eagles, fox, great blue heron, owls, raccoons, skunk, snapping turtles, turkeys; there have been more dead mollusks floating on the water this year
