- **Wildlife:** Various wildlife sightings including deer, rabbits, bear, turkeys, bald eagle, loons, porcupines
- Dam: Per Dan Peaco's report of July 2019, dam is in good shape; brush around dam will be cut back; Dan will approach Otisfield selectmen for water gauge again and if obtained, will put it on the dam

Watershed Information:

- Water Conditions:
 - Water Testing Clarity & Phosphorous Steve Markarian's Report: In 2019, Steve tested Saturday Pond 12 times for water clarity & once for phosphorous.
 - Water Clarity: Better than average. Lower in spring probably because of rain. Clarity improved in July & August.
